Joseph Legree, retired priest of the Diocese of Pembroke, who died on August 28th, and whose Mass of Christian Burial was offered by Most Reverend Bishop Guy Desrochers on Thursday, August 31st. Fr. Legree was Pastor of St. Andrew's Church in 1990. Fr. Legree's love for the parishes and people of the Ottawa Valley was evident in his service as diocesan historian and in 1988 he published *Lift Up Your Hearts*, a history of the Diocese of Pembroke.
