Knights of Columbus Meeting: Wednesday, April 24th at 7:00 p.m. in the Rectory Meeting Room.

<u>Adoration</u>: We are in need of individuals who are willing to commit to spending time in the church for Wednesday adoration. Ideally, three or four people committed to one hour would allow for those involved to come twice a month or be willing to replace someone committed to that hour. This time of prayer is invaluable as we have so many needs to pray for. Please consider forming a group to take part in the spiritual exercise. Volunteers can submit their names to the parish office.

<u>Cemetery at St. Andrew's</u>: The government body overseeing cemeteries has asked that we secure the site where the skull was recently discovered. Consequently a tarp has been placed over the sand pile. We ask that no one disturb it. The investigation is on-going.

<u>Confessions</u>: The priest will try to be available one-half hour before Masses. If you wish to make a confession, please try to come early. As he needs to prepare himself before Mass, he will exit the confessional at least ten minutes before the celebration.

<u>Printed Material</u>: No printed material should be placed in the church without prior authorization from the Pastor or Administrator.

<u>Parish Council</u>: Every parish is to have a property and finance council and a pastor council. In smaller parishes, one council is often formed. Such is the case at St. Andrew's. Usually, a specific term is set for membership but, again, it may be longer due to few parish members. Presently, some of the members have been on the council for several years and some may not be able to continue serving at this time. Consequently the Council will be reconstituted. Members are appointed by the Pastor/Administrator. A term limit may/can be set. This Committee is strictly consultative with final decisions being made by the Pastor/Administrator. Please know that any practicing parishioners are welcome to attend meetings.

Pastoral Council Report from Our Lady of the Angels: The following items were discussed:

- 1. Seed will be spread around the Rectory and Cemetery in the areas recently cleared.
- 2. Fire bushes will be planted along the road on the older side of the cemetery.
- 3. Gravel will be spread in front of the church to level the area.
- 4. The church may be sprayed to deal with the problem of flies and lady bugs.
- 5. As the indoor bathroom facility is being used more regularly than was intended, it has been decided to renew the privy for use during the warmer months.
- 6. It was decided to replace the propane heating system in the sacristy for a more economical heating system.
- 7. The roof on the older portion of the hall will be replaced.
- 8. The propane tanks presently used for the stoves in the hall may be removed and replaced with smaller tanks owned by the Parish.
- 9. The toll bell is presently difficult to ring and the issue will be examined.
- 10. The repainting of the church was discussed briefly. It will need to be done within a few years and will be a substantial cost.
