<u>Petition at the church entrances</u>: A petition has been placed at the entrances to both churches which you may wish to sign. It regards the providing of euthanasia at the Madawaska Valley Hospice & Palliative Care Facility in Barry's Bay. The petition reads as follows:

Firstly, we wish to express our profound gratitude for all the blessings the community has received over the last 10 years through Madawaska Valley Hospice & Palliative Care facility. Because of the dedication & commitment of the staff, volunteers, and medical professionals it has served the needs of the people of this area exquisitely. Your services are held in high regard.

It has recently, however, come to our attention that euthanasia (AKA MAID) is occurring on the premises, albeit rarely and through a third party provider. This has caused deep grief & distress for many, many in the community and violates the very purpose of a hospice as we understand it.

As it is not necessary in Ontario that euthanasia be performed in the hospice setting, we request that you desist from this practice and gently inform potential patients before they are admitted, that should euthanasia be sought, it would have to be performed off site.

This would provide protection for staff who disagree with the practice, and for the many, many people who would be horrified to be put in a bed where a murder/suicide had occurred (St. John Paul II insisted that we call things by their proper name and that is, in reality, what MAID is). Perhaps it would also provide a sober second look for those contemplating euthanasia.
