Notes from the Pastoral/Parish Council Meeting:

1. Norm Edwards has been named the new chairman.
2. Parish finances were reviewed and a financial statement for 2023 is attached. If there are any questions or concerns regarding the finances, please contact Joanne Murray in the office. We thank you for your continued generosity.
3. Parish envelopes for 2025 have been ordered. Next year an envelope for "Debt Relief" will replace the "Church Supper Support" envelope. A second envelope for the relief of debt will also be included. At present we owe \$16,000 from a loan acquired from the Diocese for the work which was done on removing the carpet, restoring the church floor and repairing the roof.
4. Paving will be done within a few weeks. Donations to date total \$950.
5. An archaeologist and an assistant will attend to the concerns regarding the discovery of human remains in the sand pile in the next few months. The cemetery will be more securely managed in the future.
